**TERMS OF THE DECISIONS:**

- I. After reviewing the Appeal brief as well as Universal Serial Bus (USB) submitted by the Appellants. The Appeal Committee is of the view that in light of the proof submitted by the Complainant/ Respondent and in absence of any record submitted by the Appellants before the Disciplinary Committee as well as the Appeal Committee, the presence or involvement of the Appellants in the incidents that took place in 2021 was vital and cannot be denied that they were a part of the group which encouraged/outrightly supported a parallel

association which is in violation of the Article 70 of the PFF Constitution. Thus, the Appeal Committee finds no reason to hold contrary to the findings of the Disciplinary Committee. The Appellants have failed to submit any evidence to back their assertions before the Disciplinary Committee as well as the Appeal Committee.



- II. The Appeal Committee is not of the view that the Complainant had any mala fide or ill intent to specifically derail the Appellant's election. The Complaint was only filed for the protection of Football in Pakistan which already has gone through tremendous amount of chaos and disorder in the past.
- III. Furthermore, all other objections raised by the Appellant concerning the admissibility and jurisdiction of the Disciplinary Committee to adjudicate upon the case are devoid of any merit and are hereby dismissed.
- IV. The Appeal Committee unanimously upholds the Impugned Judgment dated 29<sup>th</sup> of July 2024 passed by the Disciplinary Committee in Complaint No.021/2024.

Let the copy of this order be communicated to all the affiliated units of PFF and each Department. Moreover, the PFF is also directed to ensure the compliance of this order.

The detailed rationale behind the judgment may be provided to the parties, if it is requested.
