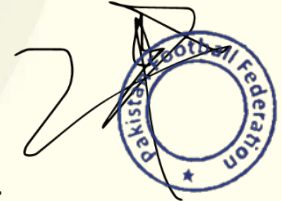

27th of August, 2024

Terms of the Decision:

- After reviewing all the facts, it has been determined that the following individuals were involved in creating a parallel association, which is strongly discouraged by the PFF Constitution, Rules, and Regulations. Additionally, they violated Article 70 of the PFF Constitution and are therefore declared Persona Non Grata. They are banned from participating in any football-related activities for life.

- b. Furthermore, the following individuals were involved in the attack on the PFF House on March 27th of 2021, which resulted in Pakistan's suspension at the international level. This act of illegal takeover, stealing PFF property, destroying PFF property, and embezzling over PKR4,000,000/- resulted in the international suspension of PFF causing irreparable and lasting damage to not only Pakistan Football but to the goodwill and prestige of The Islamic Republic of Pakistan internationally. As a consequence, there is sufficient material available on record that connects the below mentioned individuals with the act they have committed against the spirit of PFF, AFC and FIFA Statutes. Thus this committee is of unanimous view that these individuals be immediately declared Persona Non Grata and banned from participating in any football-related activities for life.

Additionally, the PFF Disciplinary and Ethics Committee has noted that the movable assets of the PFF, including official cars, are in the possession of those who attacked the PFF House and formed illegal committees which they are not authorized to do. Therefore, these individuals are instructed to return the assets within seven (7) days starting today. If they fail to do so, the PFF Secretariat will be required to file a criminal case against them:

Whereas the rest of the individuals who were named in various standing committees, their cases will be dealt separately. Moreover, it must be noted that the individuals who are already banned by PFF Disciplinary and ethics committee on the point of forming parallel association are the part and parcel of this decision.

Let the copy of this order (each page signed by Chairman of Disciplinary committee) be communicated to PFF secretariat.

Let the copy of this order be communicated to all the affiliated units of PFF and each Department. Moreover, the PFF is also directed to ensure the compliance of this order. The detailed rationale behind this decision will be communicated accordingly.

Let the copy of this decision be communicated to the FIFA and AFC immediately after the signing of this decision.

If any of the affiliates of the PFF tried to establish contact with the individuals mentioned above then strict action shall be taken against them.

The PFF Secretariat, if it deems appropriate, can announce and publish this decision (wholly or the relevant portion of the judgment) to the general public, on its official website or social media pages.

The PFF Secretariat is directed to submit the compliance report before the Disciplinary Committee.

Note Relating to Appeals

- a. The aggrieved party shall communicate their decision to file an appeal in writing within fifteen (15) days of the communication of this decision.
- b. As per inter alia Article 127 of the PFF Disciplinary Code and Ethics, the aggrieved party must pay the Appeal Fees into the PFF designated bank account within seven (07) days to formalize an appeal. Otherwise the appeal is inadmissible without this deposit [Article 127(2)].
- c. Failure to do so will result in the decision becoming final and binding.
- d. The Time Limit to lodge an appeal begins upon receipt of the grounds of this decision.
