**Subject: Public Notice of Compliance with the Decisions of the
PFF Disciplinary & Ethics Committee**

The PFF Secretariat is following the Judgments from July 29, 2024, under Complaint No. 21/2024, and August 2, 2024, under Complaint No. 027/2024, in the cases involving "Muhammad Anwar vs Abdul Nasir Karim Baloch and others" and "Muhammad Yameen vs Fateh Baloch and others." Excerpts from these decisions for reference appear below:

"Therefore, this Committee feels necessary to direct the PFF Secretariat to provide the details regarding the period when the Parallel Associations were formed and the name of each individual who remained part and parcel of those bodies in the past from the period of 2017 onwards as well as provide details regarding the loss to the PFF assets within a period of Three working days from the date of communication of this decision, and the separate proceedings shall be initiated by this Committee as per PFF Constitution, laws, rules and regulations."

Further in Complaint No.027/2024 the PFF Disciplinary And Ethics Committee directed the Secretariat in the following terms:

"The legal representative confirmed that the PFF Legal Department is in a process of compiling the same in order to ensure the compliance of the decision dated 29th of July, 2024 and the detailed report shall be submitted before this Committee accordingly with a period of One Week. Therefore, the extension is duly granted to the Secretariat to ensure the compliance of the judgment."

Compliance:

In compliance with the above decisions, the Secretariat has provided the relevant information to the PFF Disciplinary & Ethics Committee. The list of individuals was available in the record found of the Parallel Association (as defined in the PFF Constitution) itself. Copies of said records have been provided which includes details of Parallel Associations that were operating during the years 2018, 2019, 2021 and 2022.

Details regarding the loss to PFF Assets, misappropriation and damages has also been provided to the PFF Disciplinary & Ethics Committee, including details of bank accounts, vehicles, records and furniture & fixtures.
