Facts of the Matter:

- i. The fact of the matter is that during the match between Burma Afridi and Gulshan Ittihad held at Baloch Mujahid Ground on 11 March 2026, there was a significant breakdown in organization and crowd management. The incident escalated to a point where violence erupted, resulting in the assault of the match official referee.

- ii. That the video evidence clearly shows that the referee was beaten and attacked by individuals involved in the incident, an act that could have led to life-threatening injuries.
- iii. That the Complaints was referred to this Committee by the Respondent No.4 and prayed for the initiation of the appropriate proceedings as per the PFF Constitution.
- iv. The Legal Department of PFF also requested that the concerned Football Association may kindly be impleaded as the proper party in the proceedings for appropriate assistance in the matter.

ORDER:

In light of the serious concerns regarding the poorly organized conduct of the match between Burma Afridi and Gulshan Ittihad at Baloch Mujahid Ground on 11 March 2026, and the evident lapses in crowd management and security arrangements, this Disciplinary Committee hereby issues the following orders:


- i. The tournament is hereby SUSPENDED with immediate effect until further notice. No matches involving the aforementioned clubs or any related activities shall take place until a thorough review is conducted and satisfactory security and organizational measures are implemented.
- ii. The clubs involved, Burma Afridi and Gulshan Ittihad, shall remain inactive in Pakistan Football Connect (PFC) until the completion of the disciplinary proceedings.
- iii. The Pakistan Football Federation (PFF) Secretariat and the Pakistan Football Referees Association (PFRA) are hereby directed to submit a comprehensive, detailed report regarding the incident, the organizational lapses, and security failures within three (3) working days from the date of this order.
- iv. Further, the video evidence reflects that the match official referee was assaulted during the incident, an act which could have resulted in life-threatening injuries. Such violence against officials is a serious violation of the Disciplinary Code of the PFF, as well as FIFA and AFC regulations.
- v. This Committee considers such incidents a grave threat to the safety of players, officials, and spectators and a clear violation of the Disciplinary Code. Any similar events or incidents of violence or misconduct are strictly prohibited and shall be met with severe disciplinary action.



All activities related to the event shall remain suspended immediately. Any ongoing or future activities are to be halted without delay. Furthermore, the details of all individuals involved in the incident must be provided to this Committee immediately for investigation and disciplinary proceedings.

Notice is issued to the Respondents as well as Complainant No.2 and 3 for 17th of March, 2026 for the submission of Comprehensive report.

Strict compliance is mandatory.
